## Cumberland County Maine Deed Project Sample Deed and Translation by Carol P. McCoy, Ph.D.

Joshua Curtis to Benjamin Ingersoll et al. (Cumberland Deeds 6:3-4)

Following is a copy of a complex deed as it appears in the original Deed Book Vol. 6 pages 3 and 4. After that is a translation including the spelling as best I can read it. Note, there is often no comma between names. Capitalization seems random. Words are broken up on two lines with no hyphens. Note: Most deeds do not have this many parties, however, some Estates do.

- Date Executed is often written out long hand—it is the date when they the grantors their seals.
- Date of Record is when the deed was entered into the deed books.
- Note: sometimes there are dates of acknowledgment in between these two dates—we are not capturing these dates for our project.
